I HAVE A CONFESSION

It is my desire that we begin by worshipping whenever we get together (in small groups, meetings, etc). We have all learned how to read the Bible and pray in our individual devotional times, but do we fully know what it is to worship God in our own prayer closets?

As I prayed and worshipped in preparing this, I listened to a song by Rita Springer, called "Defender" (search for it on YouTube, iTunes, Amazon Music and elsewhere and listen to it). In the song are these lines: "You know before I do | Where my heart can seek to find Your truth | Your mercy is the shade I'm living in | You restore my faith and hope again | All I did was praise | All I did was worship | All I did was bow down | All I did was stay still". It struck me that all of our striving for spiritual growth, vitality, "church growth" etc. is all in vain unless the Lord is the center, truly the center, of our lives and our worship of Him emanates from that center.

So I need more time; time to study, time to pray... to fast... to worship and to listen for God's still small voice in leading me into this very important season. Will you pray with me, and for me? Will you ask God to reveal His plan for The Fount, moving forward, that we can dive deeper into worship, deeper into the Spirit, deeper into the Word, and deeper into the kind of ministry that will truly transform our lives and our world?

I am excited about this next season in our lives and where God is going to take us. I am full of hope and anticipation!


FVUMP (PRESCHOOL) SET TO RE-OPEN
